

Status of Medical Support

Tier 1

- All sites supported by GoRN
- 6 sites in SPAs 2, 4, and 5 are getting additional medical support from LA Christian Health Center, Northeast Valley Health Corporation, and Venice Family Clinic

Tier 2

- All sites in SPAs 3, 6, 7, and 8 supported by a combination of East Valley Community Center, JWCH, Helping Hands, and DHS
- DMH providing on-site support

Tier 3

- All sites supported by GoRN
- All sites in SPAs 2, 4, 5, 6, and 8 are getting additional medical support from UCLA Dept of Family Medicine, DHS Ambulatory Care Network, Cedars Sinai Mobile Clinic, and Venice Family Clinic
- DMH providing on-site support





Major Coordination Movements

- Twice-weekly coordination calls managed by LA City
- Weekly coordination calls managed by CCALAC
- Weekly street medicine coordination calls managed by DHS-HFH
- Request for Information put out by LAHSA
- Consolidated Site List being Managed by United Way

Level Setting & Orientation

- All Tier 1 and Tier 3 sites have Go RN support staff, who provide COVID symptom checks as well as an
 expanding array of care, including COVID testing at some sites and wellness checks
- DMH is providing services at all open MSEP sites

Project	# of sites with a medical partnership	SPAs
Tier 1 - Project Roomkey	6	2, 4, & 5
Tier 2 - Q/I Sites*	6	3, 6, 7, & 8
Tier 3 - MSEP (including trailer sites)	30	2, 4, 5, 6, & 8

^{*}Q/I sites have 24/7 medical coverage; combination of DHS and other medical staff
